- Stripes = 13 original colonies; symbol of sun rays shining down
- 1 Old Glory Red = Bravery and valor to protect freedom
- Blue field = Union
- 2 Old Glory Blue = Vigilance, perseverance and justice for all
 - ✓ Stars = 50 states; symbol of heaven and goals to reach
- 3 White = Purity and innocence for independence and truth
